



## Kewaunee Winery Tour

### Day One: Saturday, April 27, 2019 (Meals included: L)

Arrive at Harbor Lights Lodge around 9:30 am to socialize before departing by bus for the day. Our first stop is Cold Country Vines & Wines where we will experience a tour of the facility and sample some of the award



winning wines produced from estate grown grapes. We will then head north toward Algoma where we will stop for lunch, followed by a tour and tasting at the oldest winery in the State of Wisconsin, von Stiehl Winery, which celebrated its 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary in 2017. We then head back to Kewaunee to Sip & Savor at Lakehaven Hall. This event will have additional wineries available for sampling as well as other food vendors and live music.



With three local wineries winning multiple awards, it is easy to see why Wisconsin Ledge wines rival those of Napa Valley and other well known wine regions of the world!

### Day Two: Sunday, April 28, 2019 (Meals included: L)

All events held on this day will be within walking distance of the hotel. We will start the day at 10 am at Lakehaven Hall with a Wine Sensory Experience provided by the third winery in Kewaunee County, Parallel 44. This experience will change the way you see, taste and appreciate wine! We will then head to Port O' Call for lunch, over-looking the Kewaunee harbor channel.

Following lunch, the day ends with a walking tour of the Kewaunee Lighthouse and Tug Ludington (f/k/a Wilbur F. Browder), a World War II ear tugboat that participated in the D-Day invasion of Normandy. While walking to the lighthouse, to your left, just under the large hill, is Kewaunee Fabrications, formerly Kewaunee Shipbuilding and Engineering, where the USS Pueblo was built and launched in April 1944. The Pueblo was captured by North Korea on January 23, 1968, and is currently held as a museum ship in North Korea.
